- Discussion around replacing the locks and keep a register as to who has keys
- Beer system has been replaced has been done as part of the sponsorship with the Leagues club
- Bar Manager (from Brent to Adam) has been approved and progressed

Financials

- Jim Buckton talked to the balance sheet
- Currently have approx. \$10,600 in our cheque account
- \$3K in investment account has just been rolled over needs to be there to hold our credit card with the Greater Bank
- Soldiers 100 account currently holds \$14,039. These are grant funds allocated for the new IRB and \$4k grant for the replacement of locks
- Cash in hand of approx. \$28K
- No response to date from Ian Fullager in regards to HD. Suggested that this outstanding money
 be removed from the financial statements as the process that was voted on by the committee
 has been followed & the issue needs to be finalised. Note that the club would have been
 contacted had any reply been received. Suggested removal motion at the January meeting.

- Summary of items requiring approval
 - Patrol vehicle needs repairing springs, brakes, clutch and rust proofing to the value of approx. \$3K – these costs are impending
 - Suggestion received we add costs to future grant requests (repairs and maintenance)
 - Payment of trailer rego \$67.00
- Looking for approval when quote received need to move ahead with repairs

- Paperwork underway for Stronger Communities grant (received \$20,900) for floor in bar and kitchen
- Upgrade to floor will need to happen and negotiated with Brent (he will need to close to enable the repairs to be undertaken off season)
- Awaiting surf club facility grant to open will use on solar and roller doors if successful



- Junior training has increased now have over 30 which is fantastic need to ensure we look at our protocols
- Increased interest in people wanting to undertake the Bronze
- Dunes and the Kraken fundraising has been very successful around \$5K
