Completion of a 400m pool swim in 8 minutes or less. Swim Certificate must be uploaded when registering to attend this

course.

Proficient Bronze Medallion / Cert II Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)

Please note:

- Enrolment for this course will be on a 'first in best dressed' basis
- Pre-Requisite swim Certificate is required to be uploaded at time of online registration.
 (This is the responsibility of the Individual member to complete prior to attending the examination date)

Course Content:

- Contribute to preparation activities for search and rescue operations
- Recognize when a rescue response is required
- Perform complex patient rescue, including search and rescue of a missing person
- Demonstrate recovery and stand down procedures
- Advanced water entry (rock and pier rescues) (where training location permits)
- Retrievingsubmergedobjects
- On-land night search operation

Enrolment Process:

Enrolment Process: Interested members are to book through their Chief Training Officers/Secretary. Clubs are to then complete the online registration form located on the SLSCC secure members area on the SLSCC website (www.slscc.com.au)
